300 NORTH ROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION



PROJECT UPDATE

In August 2024, Salt Lake City began reconstructing 300 North from 1000 West to 300 West. This project will remove and replace failing pavement, substandard curbs, gutters, sidewalks, and curb ramps to make getting around safer and easier, whether you're biking, walking, or rolling. Once completed, the street will feature a new layout based on community feedback. Construction is expected to continue through 2025. This project will provide regular updates through a newsletter. WHAT TO EXPECT

Area residents can expect construction noise, dust, and vibration during normal working hours. Vehicle and pedestrian routes may be detoured, but access to properties will be maintained whenever possible. The project team will coordinate with individual residents if access is unavailable. Please slow down and pay attention, as lane closures, detours, and new traffic patterns may be in place during construction.

CONSTRUCTION AND WEST HIGH

Work began directly in front of West High School in late July as part of a strategy to complete work on that block before the 2024-25 school year begins. Students, faculty, and parents can expect fresh pavement on 300 N adjacent to West High School and ongoing construction on 300 N west of 500 W. Crews are aware of school-related traffic and will take it into account in their daily work. We have created signs featuring the West High logo to designate the safest and most efficient routes through active construction. Keep an eye out for the Panther Pathway signs, as shown below, as you walk, drive, or roll to and from school.

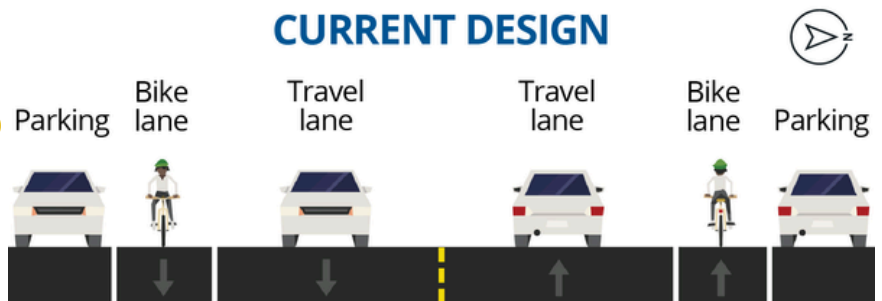
